



Health & Safety Policy Statement of Intent

With respect to Health and Safety, it is the intent of M&I Materials Ltd to provide a safe and healthy place of work for its employees and to protect the health and safety of anyone else who may be affected by its operations.

Whilst not all risks can be eliminated, we will do what is reasonably practicable to minimise risks that our employees and others may be exposed to. In this context, it is our intent that we will:

- Provide adequate resources to carry out work safely
- Provide information, training and instruction to ensure employees are competent to carry out their work
- Provide competent and adequate supervision
- Provide and maintain plant, machinery and equipment that can be used safely
- Provide and maintain safe systems of work
- Carry out periodic risk assessments of working practices
- Provide and maintain adequate welfare and first aid facilities
- Have in place arrangements for the safe handling and transportation of articles and substances used at work
- Consult with employees on health and safety matters
- Provide suitable personal protective equipment and clothing as necessary and ensure its proper use
- Follow up on incidents and 'near misses' to continuously improve our management of health and safety risks.
- Continually improve our health and safety systems to enhance health and safety on the site

We will comply with or exceed the requirements of all prevailing health and safety legislation and any other H&S requirements of the business.
